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Policies:

- The parent agrees to pay tuition every Friday by noon for the upcoming week. If tuition is not paid, a \$10.00 late fee will be assessed.
- o Tuition payments can be made by check, money order, credit/debit card, or cash.
- o If a payment is returned for insufficient funds there will be a \$35.00 returned check fee. If this occurs twice, tuition must be in the form of cash or money order.
- The center opens at 7:00 AM. Parents are asked to walk their child into the building and check in with the teacher. All children shall be in the program no later than 8:30 AM. Please call by 8:30 AM if your child will not be attending.
- o The center closes promptly at 5:30 PM. All parents must be here by 5:25 in order to allow time to pick up your child and exit the building by 5:30. If your child is here past 5:30 PM a late fee of \$3 per minute will be charged and payable immediately in cash or check to the staff member who stayed.
- At the time of enrollment, the first week of tuition and a \$100.00 registration fee is due. Registration fees are non-refundable. Parents receiving state assistance are responsible for the initial week's tuition and registration fee as well as all week's tuition until the state "links" your child.
- Tuition is payable whether the child does or does not attend Little Apples, including holidays, vacations, snow days, and/or sick days.
- The parent agrees to give a 2 week written notice if you plan to remove your child from Little Apples.
- o The Business Contract will be revised when tuition change occurs. The center's management team agrees to give a 30 day written notice of any tuition increases.
- Have your child dressed and ready to play upon arrival. Provide extra clothes, weather appropriate attire, rest mat items (sheet and blanket), diapers, four healthy snacks per day as well as a lunch and 3-4 drinks.
- Please apply sunscreen to your child prior to dropping off and provide a bottle of sunscreen for your child to use at the center.

Damages:

Both the parent/guardian and the provider will make every effort to teach the children to use materials and equipment carefully and to avoid damage done to the property that belongs to others. However, in the case of serious damage the parent/guardian agrees to cover the cost of replacement and repair.

Illness Policy:

Your child can not attend if he/she is sick. If your child becomes sick during the school day you will be called and you will need to pick him/her up. Please read and understand the sick policies outlined in your Parent Handbook. If your child requires over the counter medicines, we cannot administer them, therefore they should remain at home. Please consult the medication administration policy as outlined in the Parent Handbook.
